

The ANCAN Scholarship Scoring Rubric

The following guidelines will be used by the review committee to evaluate the scholarship application.

Criteria 1: Applicants must be a financial ANCAN member for the last 2 years		
0 = point	3 = points	5 = points
Is not currently a financial ANCAN member. Is a current financial member of ANCAN. But has held member status for less than 2 years.	Is a current financial member of ANCAN. Has held 2 years continuous membership.	Is a current financial member of ANCAN. Has held more than 3 years continuous membership.
Criteria 2: Applicant must have attended a local ANCAN educational event in the last 2 years (proof of receipt required)		
0 = point	3 = points	5 = points
Has never attended a local ANCAN educational event.	Has attended one local ANCAN or CFA educational event in the last 2 years.	Has attended more than one local ANCAN or CFA educational events in the last 2 years.
Criteria 3: Applicant must not have received a financial scholarship from ANCAN in the last 2 years		
0 = point	3 = points	5 = points
Was a recipient of an ANCAN financial scholarship within the last two years	It has been more than two years since receiving an ANCAN financial scholarship	Has never been a recipient of an ANCAN financial scholarship
Criteria 4: Applicants must not be receiving any financial benefit from any other source or organization to attend the National CFA Conference.		
0 = point		5 = points
Was a recipient of another financial scholarship to attend the 24 th National CFA Conference		Was not a recipient of an another financial scholarship to attend the 24 th National CFA Conference

Applicants ***must*** use the following ANCAN guide to write your 1000 word report. The report must be of sufficient academic quality to be printed in the ANCAN newsletter. No plagiarised (directly copied) content will be accepted.

Successful applicants will be made known to each other and it is their responsibility to ensure that each report covers a different aspect of the conference.

Introduction (200 words)

Provide a short background history about the presenter of the reviewed conference paper, workshop or poster.

Give a brief demographic of the conference delegates and the audience to whom the conference paper, workshop or poster was addressed.

Body of paper (600 words)

- Describe the most interesting or compelling aspects of the reviewed conference paper, workshop or poster and explain why you found them interesting or compelling.
- Provide a brief discussion about the relevance and content of reviewed conference paper, workshop or poster to you and your practice area. Expand on this discussion by using your own knowledge of the topic.
- Introduce other parallel or comparative views from other presentations and/or discussions at the conference or from published papers you have read.
- Draw on the key points made by the presenter which you viewed as expanding on the discipline of continence in terms of advancement, innovation and where research is heading in the future.
- Make comparisons to previous research in the area and make use of new ideas which may have emerged during question time.
- If available, use references or links where appropriate, to provide readers with further information about the research.

Conclusion (200 words)

- Conclude your review by summarising your overall impression of the Conference, the conference paper, workshop or poster. The benefits you gained from attending this conference paper, workshop or poster, and the 24th National Conference.
- Acknowledge the source of your scholarship that enabled your attendance at this conference.

The report is to be electronically submitted to the ANCAN committee by midnight 24th December 2015.
